Below is a list of trip activities and events. A specific itinerary will be made available as soon as we receive confirmation of our performance time and venue from the Disney coordinator.

- We will spend one day at Universal Studio's (both parks)
- We will spend one day at each of Disney's four theme parks (Magic Kingdom, EPCOT, Hollywood Studios, and Animal Kingdom)
- Two special dining experiences: (1) Multi course Italian meal followed by reserved seating at Fantasmic (2) Dinner on a private island in EPCOT located between England and France. After dinner we will enjoy a front row view of Illuminations.
- Performance in a Disney Parade at one of the Disney theme parks.
- "You're Instrumental" a workshop with a Disney music associate.
- We leave Orland the evening of Thursday, April 5^{th} , and will return to school Friday, April 6^{th} after 7:00 pm.

Money

<u>Student Package:</u>

This is an <u>all-inclusive</u> trip for the band students which includes: transportation, workshop fees, dining experiences, Disney's All Star hotel (<u>four</u> people per room), park tickets, <u>all meals</u>, and trip t-shirt. (\$1130.00)

Family Fan Package with Transportation: Parents will act as chaperones
This package includes bus transportation, hotel, dining experiences, park tickets,
and trip t-shirt. (\$1075.00) (Package has been priced at 2 people per room. Price for 1
person/room = \$1375, 3 people/room = \$975, 4people/room = \$925.)



Family Fan without Transportation: Parents will act as chaperones

This package includes hotel, dining experiences, park tickets, and trip t-shirt. (\$1145.00 - 695.00) 1 person/room = \$1145, 2 people/room = \$845, 3 people/room = \$745, 4people/room = \$695. * Transportation from Disney to Universal is not included.

Family Fans Tickets and Dining Experiences Only:

This package will include our group dining experiences, tickets, and trip t-shirt. Families may choose to purchase the same ticket package as the group or purchase one that includes fewer days or more days. Contact Becky to check on prices. (Price will vary depending on length of ticket) * Transportation from Disney to Universal is not included.

Transportation for Family Fans may be limited depending on the number of band students that choose to travel. We will give seats to students first. For every 45 people traveling we will add an additional bus. Family Fans with completed registration forms and paid deposit will be "seated" first.

Other Important Dates:

- Tickets will be purchased January 1st for participants whose payments are up to date.
- Rooms will be booked February 28th for participants whose payments are up to date.

Registering:

- 1) Record contact information for the band student's parent or guardian. This is The phone number and e-mail address we will use for sending trip updates.
- 2) Complete the registration form. Include the package each person will be purchasing, see page 2, and the cell number for each band member and adult traveling.
- 3) Record the t-shirt size for each traveler. Indicate the size as well as an adult cut or a woman's cut.
- 4) Put registration form and deposit in the band room lock box by September 1st.

Everyone who registers and sends in a deposit before September 1st will be placed on the travel roster. Students will be given seats on the bus first, but transportation may be limited for Family Fans. (FYI: This has not been a problem in the past 12 years. We will add a new bus for every 45 people riding.)

If you miss the September $1^{\rm st}$ deadline for registration contact Becky. If she has rooms at the hotel and bus seats available she will add you to the trip roster.

Refunds can be given in full until November $1^{\rm st}$. After that time full refunds will only be available if another person fills the empty slot. Requests for refunds should be made in writing to the band booster treasurer.

Chaperone Duties:

- 1) Attend mandatory meeting the week of the trip. The meeting will be held at two different times in order to accommodate different schedules.
- 2) Distribute daily envelopes with money and reminders.

- 3) Make sure kids in your group are on the bus in the morning,
- 4) Have a check in with your group <u>at least</u> once during the day. (Mr. Senkmajer will have more specific information on this later.)
- 5) Be in the same location (park) as your group at all times. Return to hotel with your group if they would like swim time.
- 6) Travel with your students back to the hotel at the end of the day. Be sure students make it back to their rooms. (We have a security company that will be outside monitoring student rooms at night.)

All chaperones will be assigned to groups that include their child, but depending on our numbers, they may also share responsibilities with other chaperones for a group that does not include their child. If you have questions about chaperoning contact Becky Kohanov.

All adults traveling will need to follow the PHS guidelines for chaperoning, including no consumption of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs.

Please put "Florida" in the memo line of all checks written for the trip.
