

### Volunteer area details:

**Fundraisers** – We have many fundraisers and are always looking for other good ideas! You can select a particular fund raiser (fruit, coupon books, etc) or we can let you know where we need the most help

**Uniforms** – Help measure & fit students for their uniforms, order and distribute accessories, perform minor repairs and check uniforms in & out before and after performances

**Hospitality** – Feeds our kids! Organizes all food activities for band events, including dinner during band camp and before football games and bagged lunches prior to competitions. Cooking is NOT required. Hospitality can also coordinate food ordering & delivery. Hospitality also works with band managers and booster board to insure sufficient supply of drinks and snacks.

**Chaperones** – Accompany the band to all events. Help with any student needs during travel & performances, take attendance and help maintain order on the buses. Chaperones are needed for football games, competitions, parades and other performances outside of school.

**Rehearsals** – We always need at least one other adult (besides band director) at rehearsals, especially in warm weather. Adults need to be present to provide OTC medications (Tylenol, ibuprofen, etc) and to assist with any medical issues (injuries, etc) that might occur

**Medical & First Aid** – Works with chaperones during band events, assists students when needed. Maintain the first aid bags (replace items as the supply is used, replace expired OTC meds, etc). ***Parents with medical/first aid background are strongly encouraged to volunteer.***

**Props** – Design, build and paint the props to coordinate with our shows. In many cases, just “painting inside the lines” is needed. But artistic talent is always welcome!

**Pit Crew** – bring equipment and props onto the field for the show and remove them after the performance. Help students load & unload equipment from trucks. Drive large U-Haul trucks to and from competitions and parades.

**Video/Photo** – arranges for videotaping and still photographs of important band events such as competitions, football game half-time shows, parades, concerts, and the spring trip.

**Website** – maintains the Band Boosters Web site

**Venue Lead** – serves as the liaison between the venue and the Band Boosters. Posts events on the web site and coordinate volunteers

**Awards & Scholarships** – Handles senior night & end of year awards. Reviews applications & awards college scholarships

**Trip Planning** -helps coordinate the annual band trip.
