President's Report

Scholarship Committee

Uniforms (Tracey Bean)

- 1. Uniform committee consists of Steph Cross, Jill Coleman and Tracey Bean. They will have a return uniforms date in the next 6 weeks. The cleaning and care is posted on the website.
- 2. The committee is thinking about changing to getting all of the uniforms dry cleaned in bulk instead of individually. They are also thinking about possibly washing all the raincoats in bulk.
- 3. If this is the case, they would raise the students participation costs \$10-\$15/student.
- 4. They also suggested that we have a seamstress come in and take care of all the alterations.
- 5. They will be working on getting some firm numbers so it can be addressed before the start of next year.
- 6. Georgia Myers brought up not tying the new costs directly to the uniforms since some of the students don't need them.
- 7. Kelly Mowery brought up tying it to the participation costs because the costs were so low.
- 8. Ms. Tink brought up possibly putting together a sewing committee like we have had in the past.
- 9. If we change the way we do fittings, we would need to talk to Mr. Freda and see what works for him. We discussed possibly doing it during band camp.
