General Membership Meeting Minutes

June 1, 2020

The meeting was called to order at 7:03 pm via Zoom

2nd Vice President's Report (Denise Nase): Denise reported that Concert Sundaes are cancelled for the summer. It is a community outreach opportunity for the band. Non profit groups provide food for the concert attendees and scoop Ice cream. Since the cost to participate and for the ice cream has gone up, this is no longer a profitable fundraiser for us and we will ask to be removed as a host.
